- Please keep the submission to a 2–3-minute read. People have short attention spans.
- We currently have no rule regarding the number of submissions you can make. Your writing could be broken up into several posts if you have a longer story to tell.
- No profanity is allowed. Yes, you can use symbols - @\$%&*
- We recommend that you have someone you know and trust proofread your submission prior to submitting to My Autism Ally. They may catch things that we might not when it comes to sharing your story on a global platform.
- My Autism Ally reserves the right to edit submissions. We consult with the author of the blog post during this process.
- We are not political organization. Any writing submissions that promote a political party will not be considered.
- My Autism Ally has the final say as to whether or not a proposed submission is published.
- We do not financially compensate writers for their submissions.
